The Data Watch Section in Schmollers Jahrbuch – Journal of Applied Science Studies offers descriptions as well as discussions of data sources that may be of interest to social scientists engaged in empirical research or teaching courses that include empirical investigations performed by students. The purpose of this section is to describe the information in the data source, to give examples of questions tackled with the data and to tell how to access the data for research and teaching. Schmollers Jahrbuch started with articles and data from German speaking countries that allow international comparative research. While most of the data will be at the micro level (individuals, households or firms), more aggregate data and meta data (for regions, industries, or nations) will be included as well.
